

Operations Shift Team Leader

Responsibilities:

Reporting to the Chief Steam Engineer, the Shift Team Leader assumes supervisory responsibility during a rotating 12-hour shift schedule for the care and control of the production facility which includes the Waste Heat 42 MW steam turbine power plant.

Qualifications:

- Minimum of 2nd Class Power Engineer Certificate.
- At least 5 years of industry related experience is a strong asset.
- Strong communication skills, and capable of resolving problems independently.
- Demonstrated ability to work in a team-based environment.

This position requires candidates to:

- Provide supervision and leadership for their shift team.
- Ensure safe and efficient operation of all process and power plant equipment.
- Prepare shift reports and perform other administrative functions.
- Create work requests and ensure that work is completed as detailed in the job scope.
- Prepare safe work documentation, and equipment isolation for maintenance work.
- Lead Health and Safety initiatives on your shift team and ensure monthly safety audit is completed with deficiencies acted upon.
- Respond to plant upsets or incidents.
- Act as the initial Incident Commander for any emergency responses.
- Ensure on-shift regulatory compliance to the Safety Codes Act as a "Shift Engineer".
- Take the lead in troubleshooting operational problems and ensure action until there is resolution.
- Maintain targets in Cycle chemistry (WTP), Quality, and the Production output of both Electricity and Carbon.
- Operate the Control Panel for the Power Plant.
- Provide overtime relief with limited notice for the Shift Team Leaders.
- Work overtime during planned shutdowns.
- Conduct general operations training to new Operators.
- Receive training for relief roles.
- Complete minor operations maintenance and housekeeping of power facilities.
- Perform other related duties as required.
